Format for Magazine/Couplet Poem

Directions: Write a couplet (see example below). Once your couplet has been checked by the teacher, begin cutting out the words from your magazine and gluing them onto the paper. You can take a picture and upload that picture into your Google Slide or you can type your final into your Google Slide and change each word/letter's font to make it look like it is cut from a magazine

Couplet: A couplet consists of two lines of poetry. Both lines have the same amount of syllables and the last word of each word rhyme.

Examples:

I saw a little hermit **crab** (8 syllables)

His coloring was oh so **drab** (8 syllables)

Lightning, thunder, all **around** (7 syllables)

Soon the rain falls on the **ground** (7 syllables)
